POTTERY CLASS INFORMATION:

Two Courses are offered this fall:

Beginning Pottery: Teaches students the basics of working on the potters wheel. Emphasis is on acquiring the skills needed to throw simple forms. Provides opportunity for handbuilding and slab construction. Introduces students to basic glazing and decorating techniques. Eight sessions.

Two sections of Beginning Pottery are offered this Fall:

Section A: Tuesday morning 9 – 12

Section B: Tuesday evening 7 - 10

First session for both of these is September 21, last one November 30

Continuing Pottery: Assumes student has a basic knowledge of pottery procedures and is able to centre clay and pull cylinders on the wheel. Emphasis is on encouraging students to hone their skills, work out their own ideas using handbuilding and wheelthrowing methods, and explore forms and decorating techniques. Eight sessions. Thursday evenings 7 – 10., First session September 23, last one November 28.

There are three studio-access options available:

	course fee
Option 1: studio access limited to class time	\$230
Option 2: add four studio-access hours per week (students are welcome during times specified in option 3)	\$270
Option 3: add 12 additional studio-access hours per week Choose from M, W, F 5 - 10 pm, T 3 -7 pm, or Th 9 am - 7 pm.	\$350

Glazing and firing of wares made in studio included in course fee.

Clay and tools are available at the studio at cost.

A deposit of \$50 is required to complete registration.
